President's Message:

We managed to open last year for a full standard schedule of 10:00 – 4:00 daily although we were "thin on the ground" – often only one person per shift with no backups. The Fisherman's Cottage: The Cottage received the Ocean County Historical Preservation Award for the best building restoration in 2022 during an event on April 13th. There is no money awarded; but we have a five-minute video about the Cottage which the County sponsored the Pinelands Regional High School to produce for us.

Tracy Anderson passed the baton in late 2021 to Denise Cleveland as our new Volunteer Coordinator. Denise kept us going again this year and reorganized the Sign of the Whale Shop and updated the bar coding system.

After 10 years as LBIHA President (plus several prior years as VP and Trustee), I am stepping down this August. I was 70 when I became President – now I am 80, with a lot less energy. Dr. Denise Cleveland - Volunteer Coordinator and Shop Manager for the past two years - has expressed an interest in running for President in August. Denise is a retired Education Administrator. She is also the Chairman for the "Island Voices" oral history project, which I feel is a very important project to attract new and younger people to the museum. I am not the only "long-timer" serving as a museum officer, and now is the time for some new, younger people to step up to replace the current "administration" while we are still around to assist with the transition.

<u>Volunteers</u>: Denise will be having Volunteer orientation meetings **May 20th** 11-1 and **June 17th** 10-noon and will email you with the information later. Please see if you can encourage some of your friends to volunteer for admission Docents or other events – **remember that we** offer a free membership for the first-year volunteers.

<u>"Island Voices" Oral History Project:</u> A Sandpaper article is shown that describes the Voices project which is still in the final planning stage. We are looking to do our first interviews in June and July, with an initial presentation in August.

<u>Attendance:</u>For 2022 our overall attendance was still only 81% of 2019-the last pre-covid year. However, paid Museum admissions were 103% of 2019. The situation was that attendance at Monday Night Talks, Chocolate Fair, Ghost Fest, and Celebrate the Season were down. For comparison, last year the Surflight Theater admissions were at 75 to 80% of 2019. People were still afraid of crowds.

Fall 2022 Activities: As mentioned above, event attendance in August and the Fall was still lower than before Covid. This was partially offset by the Psychic Fair being in October. CAP Tree Lighting attendance in December was not SRO as it usually is, but was much better than last year

Winter 2023: We had a Webelos Den from Barnegat visit in January and they had a good time.
